For your ...	Please bring	
Head	Hat with a full brim for sun safety.	
Top	Shirts/tops which <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have modest necklines</li> <li>• Have sleeves for sun-safety</li> <li>• Are long enough to cover mid-riff</li> <li>• Don't display bad slogans etc</li> <li>• Don't reveal underwear</li> </ul>	
Bottom	Please wear shorts/pants/bottoms which <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Don't expose underwear</li> <li>• Don't look like underwear</li> <li>• Are not skin-tight or revealing</li> <li>• Are at least mid-thigh long (no mini shorts)</li> </ul>	
Feet	Please wear fully enclosed shoes. You may also bring thongs, sandals, etc but these will not be suitable for some activities, so you also need your enclosed shoes.
