

Audio Visual Options at Campialba

Firm but Fair Advice:

BE PREPARED: If you plan to use A.V. Equipment at Campialba, it is your responsibility to test your connections, compatibility with your device, etc well in advance of when you need it. This will leave you time to trouble-shoot.

PLEASE DO NOT test your technology for the first time just when your movie/program is about to start. The Campialba staff do NOT consider it an emergency if you leave your technology trouble-shooting until the last minute. This is a planning issue. Please plan ahead. To clarify – if you are showing a movie after dinner, please ensure your technology is working well BEFORE dinner.

DEVICE: If you are bringing a device to display content with, please make sure you are familiar with how to use this device. If you are borrowing the device from a friend or workplace, please ensure you know how to connect it to an external screen/sound etc before you begin your presentation.

Main Meeting Room

Projector (16:9 wide format) with the following connections

Note: If you use Youtube casting via an Apple device to the AppleTV, the video will stream well. If you are streaming directly from your Apple device through the AppleTV, the connection will only allow for low resolution videos.

You will need to bring

1. Your own device to use as the source for your display.
2. Any adapters which might be necessary to connect to HDMI if you wish to use this connection.
3. Your own 'clicker' if you wish to manage a PowerPoint from the front.

DVD Player

This DVD player is connected to the projector and sound desk.

Sound Desk with a limited number of channels.

If you wish to use more than about 2 channels then you could consider bringing your own equipment. Our sound desk has a channel for Computer, DVD player and a few microphones.

Microphones

We have a limited number of mics and cables which can be plugged in at the front of the room. They connect through to the sound desk at the back.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I manage my own PowerPoint from the front of the room?

You can connect using HDMI at the back of the room and then bring a 'clicker' to progress slides when you wish.

You can also connect via wifi and simply have your computer with you at the front.

Can I just bring my material on a USB stick?

No. You will need to bring a device to play it from. This could be a computer (Mac or PC), a tablet, a phone, etc.

What if I just want to play music from my phone?

You can do this using the 3.5 inch stereo jack attached to the HDMI adapter at the back of the room.

How can I just show some pictures?

You can bring your computer or phone which contains the pictures. You can then connect via HDMI or wirelessly to the projector to display the photos. Instructions on how to do this are on the wall at the back of the hall.

Can we watch a live-stream on the big screen?

Yes. You will need to connect via HDMI cable or wirelessly to the projector first.

Does Campialba have free wifi?

Campialba has a guest wifi which works around the dining room and upstairs hall area. The SSID for this is **CYCGuest** and the password is also **CYCGuest**.

Does Campialba have movies we can use?

No. Please bring your own movie on a DVD or bring a device which can connect to your streaming service.

Dining Room

We have two radio mics in our dining room which can be used to address people in the dining room. The dining room is not suitable to activities during the hour after the end of a meal due to the need for clean-up and dishes to be done. This work is somewhat noisy.

Rec Hall

There is an amp and speakers in the Rec Hall. There is a single mic connected to it. There is also an AUX cable (3.5 inch stereo) which you can use to connect to your phone or computer to play sound if required.

Please note: Campialba has a curfew on amplified noise from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. daily.
